HSA fee schedule

The only additional fee that may apply is the HSA custodial management fee. This fee is charged on any mutual fund investments available within your HSA investment account. This fee does not apply to mutual funds you hold within your HSBA. This fee is deducted on a quarterly basis, directly from your mutual fund balances. Some mutual funds may pay 12b-1 and/or STA fees. These fees will be allocated back to your HSA investment account upon receipt from the mutual fund company.
